




What is 360 Groups?

360 Groups is a simple tool that allows groups to review and improve their online safety practice for the benefit of the group itself and for the group staff/volunteers.

Who is it for?

360 Groups is for any group that works with children. There are related tools for use by formal schools - 360 degree safe and for other organisations that work with pre-school age children – 360 Early Years

Why use it?

360 Groups is a free, powerful tool designed by award-winning online safety experts, that simplifies a difficult task. It allows you to review your online safety policies and practice, suggests improvement actions and points to good practice resources.

How do you define harmful content?






What is ProjectEVOLVE?


